CAMP FACILITIES

Eagle River Methodist Camp is located at 28 mile on the Glacier Highway. The camp lodge has been enlarged and repainted, and has a clean and wonderful dance floor!

Dances and most workshops will be held in the camp lodge. Rustic cabins have bunks with mattresses. A grassy meadow provides space for tent campers. There is a bathhouse with full facilities and hot water.

Clean “dancing-only” shoes are essential, to keep our dance floor clean. Boots make it easier to get around outside in wet weather.

We ask campers to respect the camp policy of no pets or alcohol. There is no smoking in the camp buildings. Car-pooling is recommended, as there is limited space in the parking lot.

CHILDREN

Families with children are very welcome. Parents must supervise their children. There will be no special activities planned for kids. A parent or a designated adult who is completely responsible for their safety, supervision and well-being must accompany all campers under the age of 18.

WELCOME OUT-OF-TOWN CAMPERS!

Juneau contra dancers extend a special invitation to dancers and musicians who live outside of Juneau. We will arrange rides to the camp, transportation to and from the airport or ferry, and housing in Juneau one day before and after the camp. Please indicate your needs on this registration form.

**For its 20th Anniversary - Camp DAMP 2012 welcomes
Guest Band *The Retrospectacles*
with Dance Caller *Gordy Euler*!**

The Retrospectacles are a young group of contra dance musicians whose natural enthusiasm and powerful playing have torn up dance floors all over the Northwest. Drawing from their childhoods growing up at music camps and festivals, and their early immersions in contra dancing and music, The Retrospectacles were formed in high school and have continued as a band after graduation into their college years. Though inspired by the eclectic music of today's contra dance scene, music taken from Irish, Scottish, French-Canadian and old-time traditions, the Retrospectacles play many of their own compositions now. They also arrange the music into a densely woven and highly rhythmic sound that sounds as good on the dance floor as it does on the concert stage. - *Devon Leger*


Twin fiddlers **Josie Sokoloff-Toney** and **Andrew Foster** lead the band through the twisting, turning medleys of tunes required for contra dancing, and harmonize beautifully at the same time! Andrew has competed twice at the National Oldtime Fiddlers' Contest in Weiser, Idaho. Josie was a tutor at the Festival of American Fiddle Tunes for several years.

Scotty Leach's infectious piano playing and **Ethan Jodziewicz's** burning bass lines make up the other half of the band, and have propelled dancers across many a dance floor. Scotty has acquired the ability to transition effortlessly from Appalachian old-time to New England dance music to Cape Breton style piano backup. Ethan has pursued music of styles ranging from symphonic repertoire to jazz to folk traditions.

Gordy Euler has been calling contra dances on the West Coast since at least 2000, and has also written some dances. He likes to present a program with a variety of dances, and have the dancers dance to the music as much as possible. As a musician and dancer, Gordy knows all sides of the dance community and has a great instinct for communicating effectively with bands and dancers. He was guest caller at the 35th Annual Ak. Folk Fest.

The August 3-5 Camp DAMP 2012 weekend begins with Friday registration at 3:00 p.m., followed by dinner at 7:00 p.m. and a welcome dance. Saturday and Sunday feature dances, dance and music workshops, singing, and great food. There will be dances featuring favorite bands and callers from Southeast Alaska on late Friday and Saturday nights and Sunday morning, plus daily jam sessions. Musicians and callers: Bring your instruments and dance cards! Singers: Bring those songbooks!

In the Camp DAMP tradition, campers prepare the tasty meals and each person contributes by doing about two hours of chores. The registration form includes sign-up for Friday camp set-up chores. Sign up for other chores takes place when you register. The Camp DAMP store features our guest artists' CDs. The weekend ends Sunday at 4:00 p.m., after a farewell dance and cleanup party.

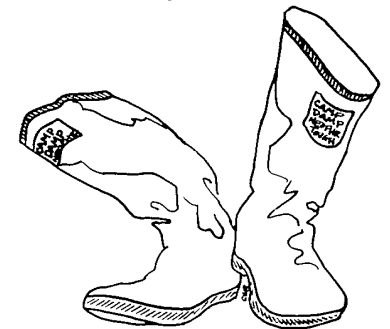
